SPOTLIGHT ON

Launched on October 1st, 2022, the project "Introducing Sustainability and Energy Efficiency Principles in Architectural Education: Towards Designing Climate Neutral and Inclusive Buildings" (INCEPT) is being implemented under the Erasmus+ Programme of the EU. The project strives for climateneutrality and inclusiveness of the built environment by incorporating sustainable and energy efficient building concepts into architectural education with knowledge and skills at building design stage.

The project consortium consists of the Department of Architecture at the New Bulgarian University (NBU), the Faculty of Urban Planning at the University of Architecture and Urbanism "Ion Mincu" (UAUIM), and the Faculty of Architecture at the University of Zagreb (UNIGZ)

FOREWORD BY THE WP LEADER UAIUM

Dear INCEPT Community,

We are pleased to share with you the latest milestones in the INCEPT project. One of the significant achievements during this period is the completion of Deliverable 2.1: *Report on the concept, methodology, and structure of the Compendium*. Coordinated by UAUIM within A.2.1, this deliverable focuses on the creation of the Compendium on the green transition to affordable and clean energy in buildings, sustainable cities and communities, and climate resilience for architecture students. This foundational document outlines the concept, methodology, and structure of the Compendium, setting the stage for its development. Key sections were defined, covering the main elements of the Compendium's structure and content. Additionally, we established the main steps of the elaboration process, along with the responsibilities of the project consortium and the timeline for the work.

In collaboration with our project partners, we have also made significant progress on Deliverable D2.2: Report on the Initial Versions of the Compendium and the compendium-related lecture course for architecture students. These deliverable details and enhances the lecture modules, lists of references, and annotated bibliography. It also includes a tool for collecting the most relevant national and international examples on the green transition to affordable and clean energy in buildings, sustainable cities and communities, and climate resilience.

Moreover, in the second semester of the current academic year (March 2024), UAUIM launched the Climate Neutral Building Design Atelier within the curriculum for 5th-year students at the Faculty of Architecture. Coordinated by Daniel Armenciu, this course has been adapted to the content framework of the INCEPT project, following the concept proposed by UNIZG in February 2023 under Work Package 3: Creation of Climate Neutral Buildings Atelier for architecture students. The atelier is currently in the evaluation phase, assessing the projects of the 100 participating students.

Our dedicated UAUIM project team includes Prof. PhD Arch. Angelica Stan, Assoc. Prof. PhD Arch. Mihaela Hărmănescu, Lect. PhD Arch. Daniel Armenciu, and Asist. Urb. Sorin Manea. In March 2023, we welcomed three new colleagues to our team: Prof. PhD Arch. Rodica Crisan, Lect. PhD Arch. Adrian Vidrașcu, and Asist. Arch. Laurentiu Pîrvan, who have joined us in advancing the Climate Neutral Building Design Atelier.
